Friends of Rapid City Parks (FRCP) Board is launching a new Greenway Days event, Friday, June 7 to Sunday, June 9, 2024.

One of the largest outdoor activities for Rapid City will take place June 7 to June 9 with recognition at the Memorial Bandshell Sunday, June 9, 10 am. Over 14 family friendly outdoor events will take place over this weekend!

This new event is an outcome of the 50th 1972 Flood Anniversary held in 2022 and the FRCP mission that began in 2012. The Friends of the Rapid City Parks mission is to keep the floodplain free of development, celebrate the greenway and commemorate the lives lost.

During the 50th Anniversary, community members discussed the importance of annually collecting, sharing, and to never forget the lives lost in the 1972 Flood. And out of the tragedy the need to educate and celebrate the greenway as the heart of Rapid City.

One of the nation's deadliest floods happened in Rapid City on the evening of June 9, 1972 that killed 238 people. The FRCP Board will continue to encourage flood stories to be gathered each year through programming offered by the Rapid City Public Library and the Journey Museum.

The Greenway is a celebration of a priceless outdoor space that links 10 miles of bike path as the icon of our city. There are over thirty City of Rapid City Parks along the greenway and throughout the city for all generations!
